HAVE A SAFE TRIP

- Cross tracks only at designated locations such as underpasses, overpasses, and grade crossings. Never go around the lowered gates at a grade crossing.
- Don't walk in front of a train, even if the train is stopped.
- Overhead electrified lines pack a lot of power. Don't go near them!
- Always stand behind the yellow line while waiting for your train.
- Watch the gap between the platform and train when boarding or detrain. Never get on or off a moving train.
- When riding on trains never lean on any doors or ride in the vestibule.
- In case of an emergency, listen to announcements and follow the instructions of the train crew. In case of smoke or fire, go to an adjoining car or, if instructed by the train crew, evacuate through the nearest exit. Directions to open doors and emergency windows are displayed near all exits.

CONNECTING SERVICE

NJ TRANSIT takes you to Newark Penn Station where you can make all the right connections.

PATH rail service at Newark Penn Station takes you directly to downtown New York. Trains also serve Jersey City and midtown Manhattan at Christopher St., 9th St., 14th St., 23rd St., and 33rd St. Call 1 (800) 234-PATH for information.

TO HOBOKEN

WATERFRONT CONNECTION TRAINS offer express service between Newark Penn Station and Hoboken Terminal for connections to New York and Jersey City. See the Waterfront Connection Service table on this schedule for details.

- At Hoboken Terminal, take the NY WATERWAY FERRY directly to lower Manhattan. The ferry entrance is next to Track 15. For information, call 1 (800) 53-FERRY.

TO PHILADELPHIA

Take NJ TRANSIT to Trenton and transfer to SEPTA for 30th Street and Suburban Stations in Philadelphia. Suggested connecting service is noted on this timetable, but these connections are not guaranteed. You can purchase SEPTA tickets at several NJ TRANSIT ticket offices on the Northeast Corridor Line. Ask a ticket agent for details. You may also purchase a SEPTA/NJ TRANSIT ticket at the vending machine between Tracks 5 and 6 at 30th Street Station in Philadelphia.

TO AMTRAK TRAINS

Amtrak trains offer service throughout the nation, with stops in New York, Newark, Metropark, New Brunswick, Princeton Junction, and Trenton. For information, call 1 (800) USA-RAIL. Amtrak will honor NJ TRANSIT weekly and monthly commutation tickets only on those trains designated with a reference note "A" in the timetable.

TO OTHER NJ TRANSIT RAIL LINES

NJ TRANSIT rail lines that serve Newark Penn Station include: Raritan Valley, Northeast Corridor, and North Jersey Coast Lines. Hoboken Terminal includes: Morris & Essex, Boonton, Pascack Valley, Main/Bergen County, and limited North Jersey Coast and Raritan Valley Line service.

TO DOWNTOWN NEWARK

The Loop serves the Downtown/Arts and Ironbound districts with mid-day and evening shuttles between Newark Penn Station, Newark Broad Street Station, and the New Jersey Performing Arts Center.

NEWARK CITY SUBWAY provides convenient service from Newark Penn Station to business and university areas of Newark.

NJ TRANSIT Buses are available at Newark Penn Station to take you to various locations in New Jersey.

TO NEWARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

AIRLINK buses provide express service between Newark Penn Station, Newark Broad Street Station and Newark International Airport. Regular departures leave every 20-30 minutes from 6:00 a.m. - 2:00 a.m. on weekdays and every 30 minutes on weekends and holidays from 6:30 a.m. - 2:00 a.m. Service will be suspended in or about January 2002.

NJ TRANSIT cannot assume responsibility for inconvenience, expense, or damage resulting from errors in timetables, delayed trains, failure to make connections, or for shortage of equipment.

ACCESSIBLE SERVICES

Stations with the above symbol are accessible to customers using mobility devices. For assistance on and off the train, please inform the train person or an NJ TRANSIT representative. When traveling to New York, inform the train person if you need to use an elevator upon arrival in New York. When departing from New York, contact NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak Customer Service to help you determine which elevator to use to access your train. When traveling from Hoboken, please arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time and notify an NJ TRANSIT representative for assistance when boarding the train.

TICKET OPTIONS

Whether you're an occasional rider or a daily commuter, NJ TRANSIT has the ticket that's right for you!

MONTHLY PASSES are the best buy for commuters. They save you approximately 30%* and are valid for unlimited trips throughout the calendar month.

WEEKLY PASSES are convenient commutation tickets. They save you approximately 15%* and are valid from Saturday through the following Friday.

10-TRIP TICKETS consist of 10 one-way trips taken within two months from the date of purchase.

ONE-WAY TICKETS can be used for one continuous ride between designated stations and are valid for one year in addition to the date of purchase.

ROUND TRIP EXCURSION TICKETS (RTX) save you up to 25%* off the cost of two regular one-way tickets. They are valid only in the direction indicated on the ticket. RTX tickets are not valid during weekday morning peak periods when your final destination or transfer terminal is Penn Station New York or Newark, Newark Broad Street Station or Hoboken Terminal. Travel to or transfer at these terminals during the weekday morning peak period requires payment of the full one-way fare from your origin station. See shaded area on this schedule for affected trains.

REDUCED FARE PROGRAM

Senior Citizens 65 and older and passengers with disabilities can travel on-board NJ TRANSIT trains at a reduced fare of one half the regular fare or less at all times (except on peak period trains noted in the shaded area of rail timetable). An NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID or Medicare Card is required to obtain the reduced fare.

Senior Citizens (62 to 64 years of age) are eligible for a reduced fare of one half the regular fare or less on-board NJ TRANSIT trains that are scheduled to depart between 9:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. and between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. on weekdays, and all day Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays. An NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare Card is required for travel.

CHILDREN'S FARES

Children, ages five through 11, save more than 50%* and up to three children, four years and under, ride free when they are accompanied by a passenger paying any fare except a child or student fare.

FAMILY SUPERSAVER FARES are available on trains and buses during weekends and holidays from 7 p.m. Friday (or the day before a holiday) until 6 a.m. Monday (or the day after a holiday). Two children, ages five through 11, may travel free with a passenger paying any fare except a child or student fare.

STUDENT MONTHLY PASSES are available. Please ask your ticket agent for details.

GROUP RATES are available for special group trips or excursions. Call the Group Sales Office at 1 (201) 714-2880 for information.

NEWARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT STATION Only Monthly Passes and One-Way Tickets are available for travel to and from the station. Reduced Fare and Promotional Fare discounts are not applicable on the Access Fee.

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CONDITIONS

NEW NEWARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (EWR) SERVICE

PERSONAL ITEMS

Aisle ways and vestibules must be kept clear of obstructions at all times. Passengers are reminded to use the overhead racks or space under the seats for such items as briefcases, luggage, handcars, or baby strollers.

RADIOS

Radios may be played with headsets or earphones only at a volume that does not disturb other passengers.

CELLULAR PHONES

Be considerate. Speak softly when using cellular phones on-board trains.

IN-LINE SKATES

The wearing of in-line skates (rollerblades) will not be permitted on-board trains.

PETS

Only service animals accompanying passengers with disabilities or their trainers, police dogs, and small pets in carry-on travel cages are allowed on-board NJ TRANSIT trains.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited on all NJ TRANSIT trains, and in all stations, enclosed platform waiting areas, and designated areas on platforms.

BICYCLE POLICY

Collapsible bicycles are permitted on all NJ TRANSIT trains at all times. Standard frame bicycles are only permitted in accessible cars and are not permitted on peak period, peak direction trains (inbound 5:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.; outbound 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.). Bicycles will not be accepted on major holidays. Visit Customer Service Offices in Newark, New York, or Hoboken, or call Customer Service for details. Bicycle storage is available at most stations. For locker information, call 1 (973) 491-7587.

Direct rail service to the Port Authority of NY&NJ's Newark International Airport Station will be available on the Northeast Corridor (NEC) and North Jersey Coast Line (NJCL). With connections at major terminals, you can travel to the station from the Raritan Valley, Morris & Essex, Boonton, Main/Bergen County and Pascack Valley lines, PATH and SEPTA. (See **CONNECTING SERVICE** section for details.) Additional information on NJ TRANSIT's Newark International Airport Station service is included in our **How To Ride Guide** available at stations on the NEC, NJCL, and Raritan Valley Line, at major terminals, or by calling 1-800-626-RIDE. **Opening date will be announced.**

TICKET AND FARE INFORMATION

NJ TRANSIT fares to Newark International Airport Station are based on distance traveled, similar to the cost of traveling to other rail stations. Only one-way tickets or monthly passes are available for travel to or from Newark International Airport Station. These tickets/passes are magnetically encoded and allow passage through the fare gates at the station. An access fee is applicable and is included in the cost of your ticket or pass to and from the station. Tickets for use at Newark International Airport Station are available from ticket vending machines (TVMs) on the NEC, NJCL, and Raritan Valley Line, at Hoboken Terminal, and Summit, Westfield and Newark Broad Street stations. You can also purchase these tickets from TVMs and ticket agents at Penn Station New York (PSNY), Newark Penn Station (NPS), and Trenton Station.

The access fee for passengers traveling through Newark International Airport Station without a magnetic ticket is \$5.00 of which \$3.50 is collected on behalf of the Port Authority of NY&NJ. These tickets are available from TVMs at the station. See **TICKET OPTIONS** and **PURCHASING YOUR TICKET** sections for more information and the **FARES** table for sample fares. For NJ TRANSIT fares from other stations, call 1 (800) 626-RIDE.

MONTHLY PASSES purchased with Newark International Airport Station as the destination allow passage through the fare gate. If your monthly pass is for a destination other than the airport, you are required to pay the access fee when traveling through the station.

ONE-WAY TICKETS purchased with Newark International Airport Station as the destination from Ticket Vending Machines allow passage through the fare gate. If you plan your return travel via AirTrain and NJ TRANSIT, you should purchase two one-way tickets prior to departing from your boarding station.

TICKETS PURCHASED ON-BOARD TRAINS are not magnetically encoded and do not include the access fee. You will be required to pay the access fee when traveling through the station. Also, you may be required to pay a penalty for purchasing a ticket on-board.

REDUCED FARES for senior citizens and **PROMOTIONAL FARES** including children's fares are applicable only on the NJ TRANSIT portion of transportation in accordance with existing rules and policies. The access fee is not eligible for discount.

TRAVEL TIPS TO/ FROM THE AIRPORT

Plan your trip by first contacting your airline for recommended check-in times and baggage check procedures. Consult a rail timetable or contact us (see **WHERE TO REACH US** section) to determine the train you should take to arrive in time. Note: Allow enough time for traveling through the station, terminal, and onboard AirTrain (add extra time to check in, check baggage and to clear security). There is no NJ TRANSIT service to or from Newark International Airport Station between 2 a.m. and 5 a.m.

Get to an NJ TRANSIT Station by arranging a ride to the nearest rail station with service to Newark International Airport Station. Parking at stations is limited, and overnight parking may not be available. If you plan to park at your local station, check with the parking lot operator to determine rules and availability. **There is no parking or passenger drop-off area at the Newark International Airport Station.**

Purchase tickets in advance from a rail TVM or a ticket agent.

Travel light as space is limited on-board trains during weekday peak periods (6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.) and on days surrounding holidays. Store belongings on overhead racks or space under the seats. Aisles and exit vestibules must be free of obstructions at all times. **Gather your belongings before you arrive at Newark International Airport Station for quick detraining.** Be aware that **train crews will not be available to assist with transporting baggage on and off the train.**

Arrive at Newark International Airport Station where you need to transfer to AirTrain for service to the airport terminals. Cross the pedestrian bridge and follow AirTrain signs. You must insert your magnetic ticket into the turnstile. (See Ticket and Fare Information section.)

Board AirTrain which provides service every three minutes during peak periods and every 15 to 20 minutes during off-peak hours to Terminals A, B, and C. Maps at the station and on AirTrain cars identify airlines serving each terminal. **AirTrain will not serve the Newark International Airport Station when NJ TRANSIT trains are not in service, 2 a.m. to 5 a.m.**

Arrive at your terminal and following check-in and baggage check procedures.

Your return trip is easy. After you pick up your baggage from baggage claim, check an NJ TRANSIT train departure monitor that will be located at AirTrain entrances in each airport terminal, to confirm your departure time. If you did not pre-purchase your return trip train ticket, buy one from a TVM located at Newark International Airport Station. Additional machines will be installed at AirTrain entrances of each terminal by the end of 2001. Luggage carts cannot be used to transport luggage to NJ TRANSIT train platforms.

If your flight arrives after the station has closed, information on alternate ground transportation is available near baggage claim. Taxi and limo service, as well as passenger pick up, are not available at the Newark International Airport Station.
